WEATHER CONDITIONS

2017-2018 winter was characterised by cold temperatures and high rainfall, and the precious water reserve were abundant in the soils.

There was an important pressure from the mildew as the spring season was very rainy. Our sandy and gravelly soils benefited from a very hot and dry summer which allowed us to gain optimum ripeness with some dehydrated berries as a counterpart.

HARVEST

Harvest took place with ideal weather conditions. The quality of the crop was beautiful. The hot summer gave the berries a very concentrated amount of colouring matter and tanins as well as giving lower yields because of an important hydric loss.

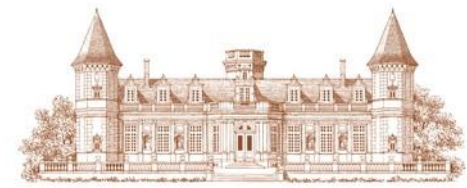
