WEATHER CONDITIONS:

The year 2021 was marked by a major frost episode in the spring which caused targeted losses on the Merlot.

The summer season took a long time to settle in, although there was plenty of sunshine from August onwards. The singularity of this year's climate gives particular nuances to this vintage.

These climatic conditions will impact our yields, which, as in 2020, will be slightly lower than in previous years.

HARVEST

The harvest was spread out over ten days from 22 September.

The harvested grapes are generous, with a good phenolic maturity. They have a remarkable softness and brightness that is conducive to the production of elegant and harmonious wines.

This is an atypical blend for Chateau Beaumont 2021, which brings a nice freshness, fruit and silky tannins to the wine.

The Merlots have very nice ripe fruit, the Cabernet Sauvignons are powerful with fine tannins.
